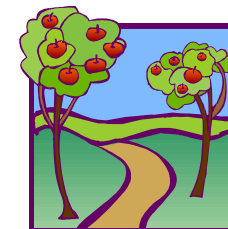

A dozen WWM members have signed up for the trip to Branson on the Road at Amish Acres.

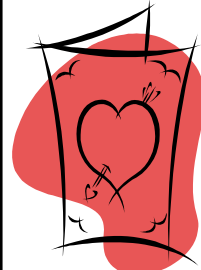

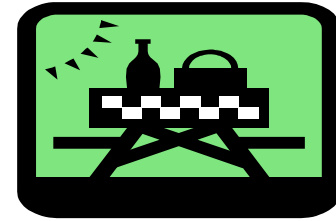
